

2019 Legislative Highlights

HB 466 - Structured Family Caregiver Waiver

This bill adds structured family caregiving as an agency-directed model to the MO HealthNet Program to ensure the availability of comprehensive and cost-effective choices for a MO HealthNet participant who has been diagnosed with Alzheimer's or a related disorder to live at home in the community of his or her choice and to receive support from a caregiver of his or her choice. There is a Cap of 300 participants.

2019 Legislative Highlights

SB 441 – Modifies provisions relating to Mo HealthNet Home and Community Based Services

This act modifies service plans of participants in the home and community-based services authorized by the Division of Senior and Disability Services within the Department of Health and Senior Services from maximum numbers of units of services to maximum monthly cost allowances (Case Mix), as determined by an assessment of the participant. The Department shall develop an interactive assessment tool (Mobile Assessments) for utilization by the Division when implementing the assessment and authorization process.
